We are looking to identify these people in connection with an ongoing theft investigation, where over £100,000 worth of goods were stolen.

Officers were called to a storage unit close to the A120 in Braintree on 17th. February following reports of four storage units being broken into.

Over £100,000 worth of items were stolen including designer shoes and movie memorabilia.

Investigating officers have continued to investigate and carry out multiple enquiries, including CCTV enquiries. These CCTV enquiries indicated that the suspects attended the location on the 13th, 15th and 16th February. We are now in the position to release these images of people we would like to speak with in connection with this investigation.
